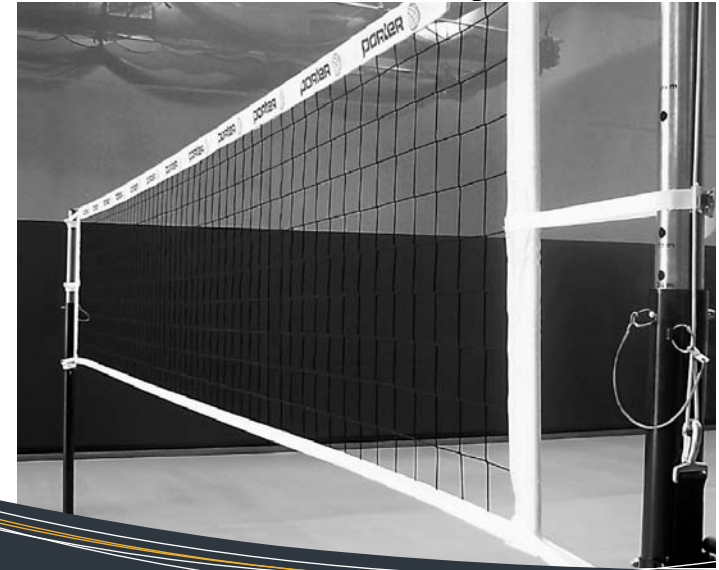
WHAT TO EXPECT

Our other Lead Coaches:

ERIKA CANDLER: Candler was the Head Coach at Iowa Wesleyan College from 2006-2009. Candler and her family returned to Wisconsin in 2009. She is a former Division I college setter. Her college career was played at Troy University and Purdue-Fort Wayne. This is Candler's eighteenth summer with Molten Volleyball Camps.

ADRIENNE DELPH: Delph is a former Bowling Green State University player. She has coached both Boys and Girls High School volleyball before moving to the collegiate level. She has coached for Heidelberg College, Owens CC, Troy University, Campbell University, and Ohio State University.

OTHER COACHES: Molten Volleyball Camps also employs different High School and Club Coaches from around the state as well as returning alumni home from college for the summer.

WAYNE KING: King is the co-founder of Molten Volleyball Camps. As an owner and director of Club Fusion and Wisconsin PoWer, King has prided himself in bringing top level training to athletes all over Illinois and Wisconsin. She is best known for her dedication to athletes and teaching them the sport she loves.
